

7. Race course

Appendix A shows the course including the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. If a gate mark is missing, the remaining mark shall be rounded on the port side.

8. Course marks

8.1. Course marks 1 will be inflatable marks, either green, yellow or red.

8.2. Mark M2a and M2b will be orange inflatable marks.

8.3. Starting marks will be a race committee boat and a spar buoy displaying an orange flag.

9. Start

9.1. The starting line will be between staff with an orange flag on the race committee signal vessel and a spar buoy displaying an orange flag.

9.2 No later than at the 1 minute's signal, the race committee shall signal the color of mark 1 by displaying a flag of the same color.

10. Finish line.

Appendix A: COURSE

Mark 1 will be located upwind, seen from the starting line.

The color of the mark that shall be rounded will be displayed with a colored flag at the starting vessel no later than the 1 minute's signal.

Mark 1 shall be passed on port side.

Marks M2a and M2b are gate-marks.

Different courses, than the normal one used **windward / leeward**, can be used.

No Pennant:

If no Pennant is hoisted on the starting vessel, the course sequence should read:

Start - M1(R/G/Y) - M2a/M2b - M1(R/G/Y) – Finish

In this case, the finish line is:

Finishing marks will be a race committee boat and a spar buoy displaying an orange flag.

The finish line will be between the two orange flags.

Pay special attention to the Finish line, and how to get to the finish line.

Pennant 1:

If Pennant 1 is hoisted on the Starting vessel, then special courses is in use

See special course system headline named: **Oure / Bane**

The courses is marked from A-H

The course sequence is written on each drawing of the course.

On the starting vessel the Course letter is written on the black board on back on the Starting vessel.

In the J70, the RACE committee will see to, that the sketches for the chosen course is onboard.

Always check the letter on the back of the Starting vessel before start !!!!!!!!!

Course: A + C + D + E + F + G + H

In this case, the finish line is:

Finishing marks will be two spar buoys displaying blue flag.

The finish line will be between the two blue flags.

Course: B

Finishing marks will be a race committee boat and a spar buoy displaying an orange flag.

The finish line will be between the two orange flags.
